3 steps to beautify YOUR block of DC

- STREET TREES Look for gaps in the row or bad trees that should be removed. Choose tree species you prefer. Request the City to plant them.^a
- **2 SECOND ROW** Look for land between the sidewalk and the buildings that is suitable for growing trees.^b The facing property owner or block association may plant there, after Miss Utility has marked the underground lines.^c
- **REMOVE VIEW-BLOCKERS** Persuade neighbors to remove unsightly shrubs, small trees and fences that block one unified street view. City rules prohibit fences, etc. higher than 3 feet in the "parking."

a The DDOT Urban Forestry Administration (UFA) plants trees using 311 b In Washington DC this is city land called the "parking". Why ? Because the city wants it to look like a park !
