HOW OFTEN TO WATER

STREET TREES

- Water 3x a Week for 10-15 Minutes
- · Weed the tree mulch bed as needed
- · Replace the mulch next spring

GRASS /SOD

- Water 3x a Week for 10-15 Minutes
- Mow as needed
