

### **RMA Mission**

We engage residents, embassies and public and private partners to plant and sustain a full canopy of trees on Embassy Row.

We promote restoration of the complete historic landscape, creating green space for the city.

We share our know-how with others who hope to "green" their streets, making Embassy Row a living classroom

Tree canopy increased 13 % in our first ten years.


EVERYBODY LIKES "INFRASTRUCTURE" – CITY WILL SPEND LOTS MORE ON IT SOON DOOT SPENDS

\$ 1 BILLION PER YEAR REHABBING OUR CITY'S STREETS.

DDOT's DECISION IN 2017 TO "REHABILTATE" ONE MILE OF HISTORIC MASS AVE by REPLACING ALL INFRASTRUCTURE would have cost a lot of trees if RMA hadn't intervened. What are the lessons?



MARP plan for a mile of Restore Mass Ave's two mile route. First MARP planwas released October 2017





# LESSON 1

### JUMP IN FAST!

- Get Plans to Consider Trees Outside Limit of Work.
- Rolled-out map on table at first public meeting was helpful. We saw bad features & responded
- Later versions to ANCs were very brief.
- We got 300-page PDF each phase and gave input.



# LESSON 2 DESIGN ELEMENTS FOR TREES - 1

**STRUCTURAL SOIL** for many street trees of 1500 cu ft. But *not* planned for Second Row trees..

**POROUS FLEXIPAVE for** many street trees. But *not* planned for Second Row trees.

KEEP SOME LARGE & MID-SIZED trees for shade during the years of construction, even trees whose health is not great.

**STORM DRAINS** Fewer than in early plans so trees collect rainfall. Locate drains away from tree rooting areas.



# LESSON 2 DESIGN ELEMENTS FOR FOR TREES - 2

**STREETLIGHT POLES** sited midway between trees leader for least cutout. 12-foot DC Globes are evenly between trees. Elegant!

**LAMPS** are 3000 K LEDs = lowest for DC arterial. They are top-shielded. But other shielding issues.

**RMA positions** were informed by DC Street Light Task Force and DC Chapter of International Dark-Sky Association



### **TEE-TUM - MARCH OF THE MACHINES**

Washington Gas pipe replacement started June 2020. MARP work started Mar 1, 2021. MARP almost finished April 2023. **25 months** 







# GAS PIPE DIGS SIDEWALKS & PUBLIC PARKING

**RMA made photo record** of all gas line cuts across sidewalk to assess future health of trees.

We asked for site meeting with Wash Gas to show our issues and learn rules Wash Gas follows in this space. Got no official meeting. Spoke with crews. Small flexible piping was used around roots not rigid metal pipes

**Problem:** Few formal rules for trenching in "the parking" beyond the MARP Limit of Work. Trees in these park-like DC land could be harmed.



# LESSON 3

# PUBLIC AT RISK FROM UTILITY PROJECT AT SAME TIME

#### **MACHINES & VEHICLES CROWD THE STREETS**

Put vehicles, bikers, pedestrians at more risk. Frightening! We plan a FOIA to Police for see if more accidents were reported.

#### **GAS LINE PUNCTURES = EMERGENCY STREET SHUTDOWNS**

They say "can't be helped" – records are old







### TREE OUTCOMES & OUTLOOK

### DDOT UFD, IPMD, MILANI-HNTB DID WHAT WAS NEEDED. THANKS!

#### **WINS**

Biggest street trees kept per plan. 42 new street trees: some new spaces.

2<sup>nd</sup> row big trees – ok but did not get flexipave, structural soil.

Unplanned loss – truck hit to avoid roadway congestion. Tree removed.

Species – RMA advised on historic and variety such as London plane.

Sheridan Circle median plantings poor.

#### **OUTLOOK**

Biggest& midsized - look ok but underground damage may hurt them.

New trees planted early were inside fences, dry, overgrown.

Sod & trees need watering! Unclear who is responsible first year.

New median plants are mostly dying. RMA declined to advise on this plan.

**BUILDINGS WILL VIBRATE** adjoining DDOT projects.

# HEALTH & MORTALITY OF TREES IMPACTED BY ROAD CONSTRUCTION

### **CHARISMATIC TREES**

- 1 21 sample trees chosen by Matt L of UFD and Matt Madeira RMA Arborist We will photograph & tell stories their outcomes
- ASSESSMENT GIS of canopy in 2020
- 3 SIDEWALK TEMPERATURE UNDER DOUBLE ROWS Alonzo A U study continues temp-taking by bicycle. Started 2022.



# ADVICE ON SPENDING \$ 1 BILLION / YR

**INCLUDE AREA BEYOND LOW** to protect trees on adjoining land and staging areas.

**FORECAST CANOPY CHANGE** for + 20 yrs, +40 yrs Compare to actual canopy as GIS is available. Set the goal of the most canopy at all time horizons.

UFD Arborist for each IPMD project and at each stage

PUBLIC NOTICE at each stage should show plans rolled out on table & give people viewing time.



### MAKE OUR 5-YEAR CAMPAIGN USEFUL

To "green" planned \$69 mill & ongoing \$836 milion DDOT

- **ASSESSMENT OF CANOPY 2020** In 2025 we learn how construction affected health of trees (or not).
- 2 IMPROVE & TEST OBSERVER APP
- POLICY CHANGES Such as scoring of engineer plans, contractor performance for proactive 'green' features
